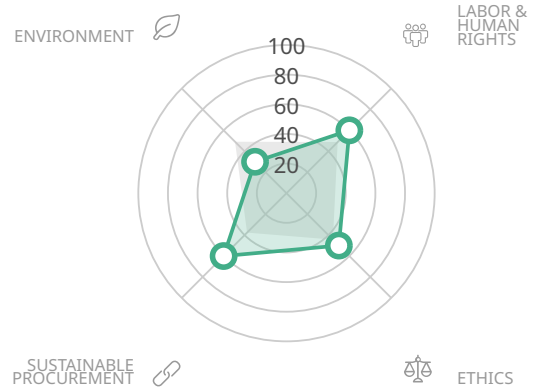


Overall score distribution
